  research the answer.
- Use of any electronic device that gives you an unfair advantage.

#### Plagiarism

- Copy or paraphrase or summarizing ideas, sentences, phrases, or paragraphs without using appropriate citation and documentation.
- Turning in another student's work as your own.
- Downloading from the internet or any other electronic source a research paper or article either in full or in part and turning it in as your own.
- Paying or asking another person to write your assignment/paper or selling or giving another student your work.
- Use of any electronic device that gives you an unfair advantage including calculators and language translation devices.

#### Lab Assignments/Reports

- · Corrupting another student's work
- Presenting another's computations, graphs, diagrams, and answers as your own work.
